Our Initiatives

Under the direction of our Board, Leadership Council, and Members, AEE focuses its efforts on initiatives and campaigns that bring the greatest benefit to advanced energy companies:

The **21st Century Electricity System** initiative is accelerating the transition to a high-performing, modern electricity system by engaging key policymakers and executives of businesses and utility companies to reform utility business models and regulatory frameworks. We provide recommendations and supporting analyses in select state regulatory proceedings such as New York's "Reforming the Energy Vision."

EPA's regulation of carbon emissions from the electric power sector under Section 111(d) of the Clean Air Act represents an opportunity to modernize the electric power system, making it higher performing and more consumer-focused while reducing emissions. AEE's member-led EPA 111(d) Campaign ensures that the collective voice of advanced energy businesses is heard throughout the regulatory process, from EPA's creation of emission reduction targets and timelines to the development of compliance plans by states. The goal is to ensure that states can take full advantage of advanced energy resources to benefit the electricity system and its customers.

In addition to the Clean Power Plan work, AEE's **Federal Policy Program** promotes the interests of advanced energy companies in federal legislation, regulation, and programs. This includes bi-partisan engagement with Members of Congress to increase their understanding and awareness of advanced energy and identify policy measures that advance the interests of the industry. AEE provides member companies with access to Congressional offices, invitations to testify before committees, and opportunities to meet with federal agencies key to their business success.

The **State Policy Program** is focused on advancing and defending policies that expand market opportunities for advanced energy companies in states around the country. Through our Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Working Groups, AEE works with member companies and state and regional partners to identify emerging threats and opportunities, mobilize the collective industry voice on legislation and regulatory issues as they arise, and lead policy initiatives in targeted states.

The **California Engagement Program** promotes the interests of advanced energy companies in a state that consistently leads the nation in energy policy and innovation. The current focus is on maximizing the impact of Prop 39 revenue and AB 32 auction proceeds, assuring effective implementation of SB 350 as well as extending AB 32 through 2030, leveraging public dollars with private funds for investment in advanced energy technologies, and rapidly increasing the number of electric and alternative-fuel vehicles on the road.

AEE's **Public Utility Commission (PUC) Program** seeks to promote advanced energy-friendly state regulations through collaborative educational efforts with utility commissioners across the country. Through regional PUC Advanced Energy Forums, we convene commissioners to help them understand how new, innovative energy technologies can make their energy systems more reliable, affordable and clean, and how they can put in place the right regulatory frameworks to maximize those benefits.

Developed by AEE's software development and policy teams, **PowerSuite** is a powerful online platform that helps AEE member companies, government agencies, academic institutions, non-profits and other subscribers navigate the complex world of state energy legislation and regulation. PowerSuite's unique platform allows users to search, track, and collaborate on state policy issues with one, easy-to-use interface. It currently consists of three products: DocketDash, the first comprehensive searchable database of public utilities commission dockets and filings; BillBoard, which tracks legislation impacting the advanced energy industry in all 50 states and DC; and PowerPortal, an energy policy "one stop shop" profiling energy use, utilities, and decision-makers state by state.
