Apex Clean Energy, which is headquartered in Charlottesville, Virginia, employs approximately 220 people and has one of the largest renewable energy project pipelines in the country. Apex is developing six projects across Ohio, in Crawford, Erie, Huron, Sandusky, Seneca, and Van Wert Counties. These projects represent a total private investment of \$3 billion and 1,800 MW of clean, homegrown energy—enough to power over 530,000 homes.
